MMS Pre-AP Program

- ❖ Pre-AP Math and Pre-AP LA will be offered at MMS for 6th graders.
- ❖ Pre-AP is open access.
- ❖ In subsequent grades, Science (7th & 8th) and Social Studies (8th) Pre-AP courses will be available.

Math Options

- Math 6 Academic (all 6th grade TEKS)
- Math 6 Pre-AP (and Math 6 Pre-AP/GT)
 - All 6th grade TEKS + 1/2 7th grade TEKS
- 6th grade GT students are no longer allowed to automatically jump to 7th grade pre-AP Math (1/2 7th grade TEKS + 8th grade TEKS). *Any* student hoping to enroll in 7th grade pre-AP Math as a 6th grader must contact their elementary school counselor to register for the Math 6 CBE or to enroll in Jumpstart.
