Math Options

- Math 6 Academic (all 6th grade TEKS)
- Math 6 Pre-AP (and Math 6 Pre-AP/GT)
 - All 6th grade TEKS + ¹/₂ 7th grade TEKS
- 6th grade GT students are no longer allowed to automatically jump to 7th grade pre-AP Math (½ 7th grade TEKS + 8th grade TEKS). Any student hoping to enroll in 7th grade pre-AP Math as a 6th grader must contact their elementary school counselor to register for the Math 6 CBE or to enroll in Jumpstart.
